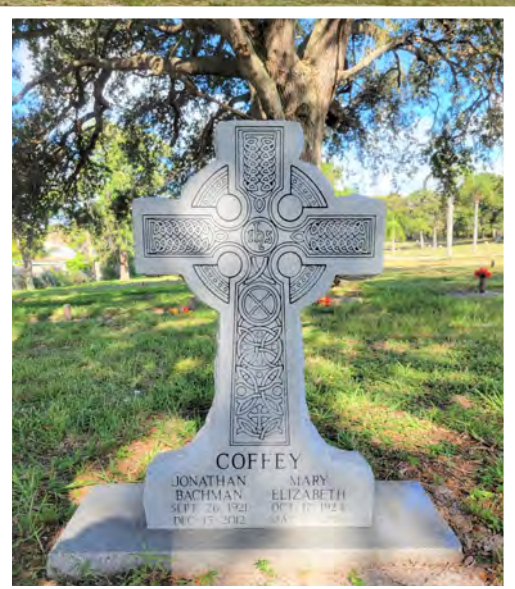
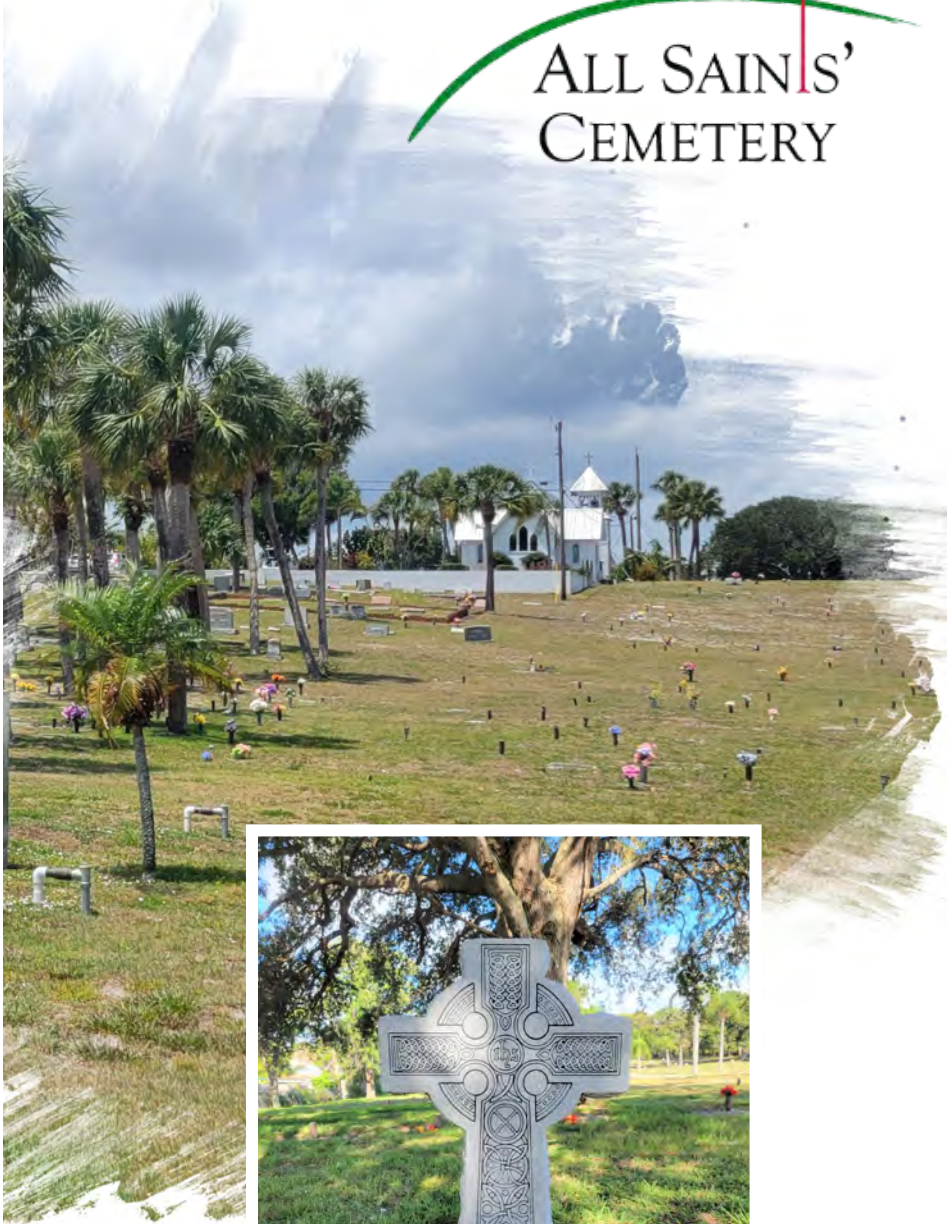




ALL SAINTS' CEMETERY



A Brief History

We invite you to consider joining the pioneers of Martin County in memorializing your loved one on this peaceful hill overlooking the Indian River.

Beginning in the early 1890s, the Cemetery was started on land donated by Charles and Mary Racey. The Cemetery was expanded in 1933, through a donation by Cliff Garrison.

The Cemetery served as the burial place for the community that was once known as Waveland, situated in Brevard County. The earliest recorded burial was in 1904. Martin County was created in 1925 and the area was renamed Jensen Beach.

Today, All Saints' Cemetery operates with a volunteer Board of Directors and four employees. It serves the people of Martin and St. Lucie Counties.

Although affiliated with the Episcopal Church, the Cemetery is non-denominational; therefore, all are welcome.

Mausoleums

For entombment burials, we offer single and true companion crypts for caskets and niches for cremains. The Mausoleums are situated next to the Serenity Garden, providing families with an area where they can memorialize their loved one in peace and tranquility.

Constructed of reinforced concrete with granite fronts, our mausoleum's beauty and construction will last for generations to come.

For cremation burials, we offer the Serenity Garden. The garden was created as a compassionate solution to provide a meaningful resting place for your loved ones choosing cremations. There are options to have the cremains scattered amongst the lush landscape as well as placing cremains in the ground naturally or in a biodegradable urn.

Our Beautiful Church Building



If you are interested in a church in which to memorialize and celebrate the life of a loved one, All Saints' Church may be that place.

Built in 1898, the beautiful Church building seats approximately 150 persons. It is accessible to the physically challenged. Larger gatherings can be

accommodated in the Fellowship Hall where persons may view the service on a large television monitor.

permission of the Rector of All Saints'.

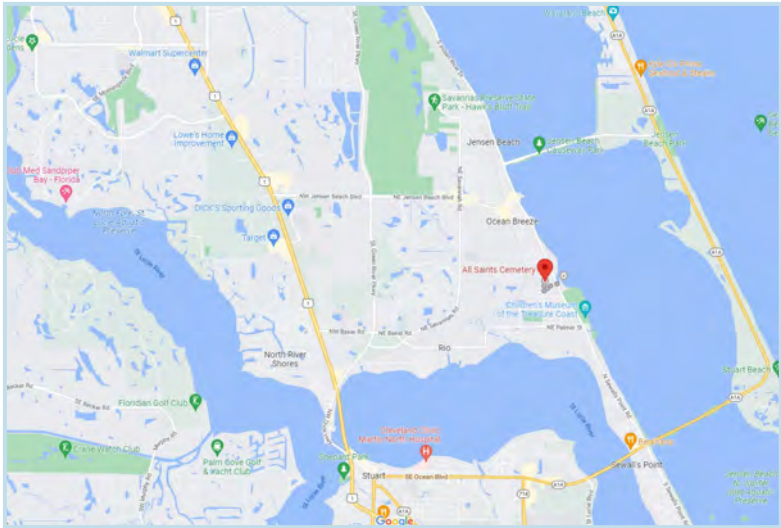
Services can be livestreamed on Facebook and YouTube for the benefit of family and friends who are unable to attend. Prior arrangements will need to be made.
